Juliette Low Box

For Daisy, Brownie, Junior Troops

This box includes a variety of puzzles and games, pictures, audio tape interview with "Juliette Low," and directions for a variety of activities to help girls and leaders learn about Juliette Low.

Journey Through Our Girl Scout Past Suitcases

For Daisy, Brownie, Junior Troops

Helps troops celebrate Girl Scout Birthday (March 12) and Founder's Day (October 31). Each suitcase includes:

- old uniforms for dress-up and fashion shows;
- old handbooks for a look at what girls did in the past;
- songbook and CD to sing your way through 100 years of Girl Scout songs;
- DVD with The Golden Eaglet, a history of GS uniforms through 1980, and a troop learning about Juliette Low on their camping trip;
- activity book with directions for games, eco-action projects, outdoor activities, and creative history fun using the items in the suitcase.

Girl Scout History Exhibit Suitcase

For Service Units/GS Communities

Contains eye-catching memorabilia and pictures that can be used to create an exciting historical exhibit about Girl Scouts. The suitcase has Girl Scout items such as:

- bandanas
- compact
- coin purses
- pocket knife
- camera
- compass
- mess kit and canteen
- sewing kit
- historical pictures

Girl Scout Camp History Suitcase

For All Troops

Learn the history of Girl Scout camping in the great outdoors. The suitcase includes:

- variety of camp uniforms dating to the 1930s
- handbooks dating to 1920s
- semaphore flags and instructions
- sample bedroll materials
- Girl Scout camping equipment
- newspaper sit-upon & how-to-make
- paper dolls depicting uniforms through the years
- display of assorted camp pins and patches

Victorian Tea Suitcases

For Daisy, Brownie, Junior Troops

Provides girls with fun, hands-on activities that will help them learn about the period (1870s) when Juliette Gordon Low was a girl living in Savannah. The focus is a Victorian tea like Juliette Low would have attended. Great to use in October to celebrate Juliette Low's birthday or February for Thinking Day or March for Girl Scout Week. Each suitcase includes a notebook with laminated activity cards and props that can be used to plan and carry out your tea.

Historical Uniforms

From a facsimile 1912 uniform to uniforms from the 2000s, the GSVSC Archives Group maintains more than 100 uniforms for troops to borrow for programs, displays, and fashion shows. Each uniform comes with an information sheet and as many accessories and insignia as are available.

HOW TO BORROW

To borrow a suitcase or historical uniforms, complete Resource Reservation Form #2159 and send it to council headquarters with the required \$25 refundable deposit. Leaders/service units/GS communities are responsible for transporting these program materials to and from council headquarters.
