Where & What to Do:

Camp Dark Hollow - Trim brush around all buildings and cabins; Walk a trail and trim brush off of the trail you're walking; Clean windows in units, and remove rocks as possible from walking paths in the units.

Camp Sacajawea - Trim brush on all trail around challenge course, around all tent platforms and buildings; Clean windows in shelters and buildings.

Camp Sugar Hollow - Trim brush on trails and roads, especially the road going to Rocky Top; Walk through main field removing any rocks that might damage a mower.
