

SENIOR DIVISION, CONTINUED

HANDBELL/CHOIR CHIMES

1. Participate in an organized group for 16 weeks.
2. Participate in at least two performances and/or festivals.

CHURCH CHOIR

1. Participate in an organized choir in your church for at least six months.
2. Participate in 75% of the church services that your choir is involved in.

SCHOOL CHORUS/CHOIR

1. Be in the school choir/chorus.
2. Practice when the group practices.
3. Be in the scheduled performances.
(pins available chorus, choir)

CHORALE

1. Singing group selected by auditions.
2. Practices when the group practices for at least six months.
3. Practice on your own at least 20 hours.
4. Participate in scheduled performances.

MADRIGAL/CHAMBER GROUP – a small vocal group selected by audition that sings mostly unaccompanied.

1. Practice when the group practices for at least six months.
2. Practice on your own for at least 20 hours.
3. Participate in scheduled performances.

SHOW CHOIR – a choir that uses choreography as well as singing.

1. Practice when the group practices for at least six months.
2. Practice on your own at least 20 hours.
3. Participate in scheduled performances.

MUSICAL - a dramatic presentation involving singing.

1. Attend required rehearsals.
2. Practice five hours on your own.
3. Participate in scheduled performances.

ACCOMPANIST

1. Practice as required with vocal group, soloist, etc.
2. Practice on your own as necessary.
3. Participate in scheduled performances.

JUNIOR DIVISION

PURPOSE: To recognize a Girl Scout's participation in a music program that may or may not conflict with some of her Girl Scouting activities, and to encourage her to develop her talent, poise, and self-confidence in order to give pleasure to others.

WHO IS THIS AWARD FOR?

This award is intended for Brownie, Junior, Cadette, Senior, Studio 2B and Adult Girl Scouts who are involved in music.

HOW TO EARN A MUSIC AWARD

1. There are 2 Divisions --
Junior Division for Brownie and Junior Girl Scouts
Senior Division for 3rd year Juniors, Cadette, Senior, Studio2B and Adult Girl Scouts.
2. Select a category. You have eight months to complete the requirements for that music category.
3. Keep a record in your Log Book. You are ON YOUR HONOR to keep your records correctly.
4. When you have completed the requirements, complete the patch/pin order form to get your patch and music pin.

SENIOR DIVISION

3RD Year Junior, Cadette, Senior, Studio 2B, and Adult Girl Scouts

PIANO

1. Take 15 hours of lessons.
2. Practice 90 hours.
3. Participate in two recitals or competitions.

INSTRUMENTALIST – girls playing an instrument other than piano not as part of an organized group.

1. Take 15 hours of lessons.
2. Practice 90 hours.
3. Participate in two recitals or competitions or share with your troop.

BAND – Marching, Concert or Symphonic

1. Be enrolled in school band.
2. Practice 20 hours on your own.
3. Participate in scheduled performances and competitions.

AUXILIARY UNITS TO THE MARCHING BAND – drum major, flag corps, majorettes, etc.

1. Practice 20 hours.
2. Participate in scheduled performances and competitions.
(Pins available for: color guard, drill team, flag, rifle)

ENSEMBLE

1. Participate in the program as it is set up at your school – such as: pep band, saxophone quartet, string quartet, etc.
2. Practice two hours a week during the time the program lasts.
3. Participate in scheduled performances.

JAZZ BAND/STAGE BAND

1. Participate in this band as it is set up at your school/community.
2. Practice two hours a week during the time the band is organized.
3. Participate in scheduled performances.
(pins available for jazz band, stage band)

*COUNTRY, ROCK, RAP BAND – this group may include singers

1. Practice at least 12 weeks with the group.
2. Practice at least two hours per week on your own.
3. Perform at least once.

*No pin available

ORCHESTRA

1. Be enrolled in school/community orchestra.
2. Practice 20 hours on your own.
3. Participate in scheduled performances and/or competitions.

JUNIOR DIVISION **Brownie and Junior Girl Scouts**

PIANO

1. Take 10 hours of lessons.
2. Practice 30 hours.
3. Participate in a recital or share with your troop.

INSTRUMENTALIST – girls playing an instrument other than piano not as part of an organized group.

1. Take 10 hours of lessons.
2. Practice 30 hours.
3. Participate in a recital or share with your troop.

BAND – pre-band instruments (recorder/flutophone, song flute) and band instruments.

1. Practice with the school group.
2. Practice six hours on your own.
3. Participate in one performance or share with your troop.

HANDBELLS/CHOIR CHIMES

1. Participate in an organized group for six weeks.
2. Participate in one performance.

CHURCH CHOIR

1. Participate in an organized choir in your church at least 16 weeks.
2. Participate in at least two church services.

SCHOOL CHORUS/CHOIR

1. Be in the school choir/chorus.
2. Practice when the group practices.
3. Be in the performances.

MUSICAL - a dramatic presentation involving singing

1. Attend required rehearsals.
2. Memorize your part.
3. Participate in required performances.
