Complete four activities.

- 1.** How does a camera work? Talk about the basic parts of a camera and what they do to make a picture.
- 2.** Show that you know how to load film into a 110 or 35mm camera.
- 3.** Demonstrate good photography skills with one roll of film. Learn how to hold the camera, how to take a picture, how to advance the film, and how take the film out of the camera to be developed. Have your film developed. Share the pictures you took with your troop. Talk about the pictures you like and the pictures that did not work out.
- 4.** Visit and tour a photography studio or camera store. Look at the different kinds of cameras they use to take pictures. Be sure to ask to see the darkroom (if they have one). Watch film being developed in a film-developing machine.
- 5.** Talk about proper camera care.
- 6.** Find out about different ways to keep photographs. There are different kinds of scrapbooks and albums. You can make one of your own or use one you buy. You can cover your photo scrapbook with fabric.
- 7.** Display pictures you have taken with one roll of film in a photo scrapbook. Properly label the pictures and put them in order.
