



## GIRL CODE OF CONDUCT

**Girl Scout Promise:**  
On my honor, I will try:  
To serve God and my country  
To help people at all times,  
And to live by the Girl Scout Law.

**Girl Scout Law:**  
I will do my best to be  
honest and fair,  
friendly and helpful,  
considerate and caring,  
courageous and strong,  
and responsible for what I say and do,  
and to respect myself and others,  
respect authority,  
use resources wisely,  
make the world a better place,  
and be a sister to every Girl Scout.

### I agree to:

- Follow the principles of the Girl Scout Promise and Law as listed in the Code of Conduct.
- Follow the rules that are made to protect others and myself, and to help make sure program activities are safe, fun, and successful.
- Treat other people, myself, property, and equipment with respect.
- Be considerate of the feelings of others.
- Be respectful of my Girl Scout Leaders. I will respect their authority and not argue with my leaders or call them names while under their supervision.
- Not react poorly if I am disappointed or feel frustrated.
- Express myself and opinions in a calm and respectful manner when voicing my concerns, asking for clarification, or asking to be heard.
- Not bully or abuse (hit, slap, spit on, or any other form of unwanted touch) my sister Girl Scouts. I understand that bullying, violence, or misconduct will not be tolerated, and my parents will be notified as well as the parents of other girls involved.
- Listen to others' ideas and thoughts. I will remember that others have ideas and thoughts, which may be different from mine, and that their ideas and thoughts are just as important as mine.
- Not make fun of the ideas and thoughts of others, and not offend anyone else with my thoughts and ideas.
- Work as a team and play well with my sister Girl Scouts when participating in all Girl Scout activities.

### I understand failure to follow our Code of Conduct will result in the following corrective actions:

- First minor offense: Review the Girl Scout Promise & Law and apologize if needed.
- Second minor offense: Review the Girl Scout Promise & Law, apologize if needed, and parent will be notified of behavior.
- Third minor or first major offense: Review the Girl Scout Promise & Law with parent and girl, and discussion between parent and leader regarding requirement of parental supervision at all future Girl Scout meetings and activities.
- Fourth minor offense or second major offense: A discussion will be held between parent, leader, and council staff regarding potential transition to another participation option.
