

LENDING PROCEDURES for HISTORICAL UNIFORMS

Thank you for your interest in sharing our Girl Scout uniform heritage with others. Since historical uniforms have great value and cannot be replaced, a refundable deposit will be charged. Damage to uniforms will result in loss of all or part of the deposit.

Uniform Identification

Each uniform comes on a hanger with an information sheet attached to the hanger bar. This information sheet describes the uniform and serves as the official inventory for the uniform. The label on each uniform has an identification number that is also noted on the uniform's information sheet. The label for dresses, blouses, shirts, etc., is located in the collar or on the interfacing. Slacks, shorts, skirts, etc., have a label located on the waistband or near the zipper. Belts, ties, sashes, and other accessories also have labels.

As the person borrowing the uniforms, please observe the following:

- The uniforms in this loan will remain in the condition received and will not be repaired, restored, washed, dry cleaned, or altered in any way without the permission of the council archives group.
- The uniforms may not be loaned to a third party without the advance approval of the council archives group.
- The borrower is responsible for transporting the uniforms to and from the council headquarters.

Modeling Uniforms

- Please match the size of the uniform with the size of the model. Be aware that a size 14 from years past is not the same as today's size 14. This is true for all sizes. If you don't have someone who fits the uniform, it is suggested that you have a girl or adult carry the uniform on a hanger.
- Please have each model wear appropriate shoes and socks or stockings. See the uniform information sheet attached to the hanger for further details.
- Please impress upon the model that she must treat the uniform with care and respect and behave with dignity since she is representing all Girl Scouts. This should not be any different than if she were wearing her own uniform.

Returning Uniforms

- Do not launder or dry clean the uniforms.
- Using the uniform information sheet attached to the hanger, please double check to make certain all pieces of the uniform, including pins, ties, belts, hats, sashes, and vests, are being returned. The number on the uniform tag should match the number on the hanger description sheet.
- Please note on the Historical Uniform Checkout and Return Inventory (#1171) any repairs that need to be made (needs cleaning, has loose buttons, needs mending, etc.) and return it with the uniforms. Also, if anything is spilled on any part of the uniform, please identify the stain on this form.
- Return the uniforms with the Historical Uniform Checkout and Return Inventory (#1171) and your Council History Program Resources Evaluation (#1172) to the council headquarters.

Uniforms Available to Borrow

Because of the age of the uniforms and the changes in how clothes have been sized over the years, sizes are not available. Uniforms cannot be shipped. Uniforms must be picked up and returned by a person who will be responsible for them. The borrower is responsible for returning the uniforms in good condition, including all the hats, scarves, sashes, pins, and badges that were on the uniforms when borrowed. Since these uniforms are not replaceable, any damaged or missing pieces will cause the forfeit of the entire deposit.
