

Dear Parents:

The Fall Product Sale will be starting on October 1. This sale is an opportunity for girls and their families to support council camps. Council proceeds from the sale support the budgetary needs for maintaining the camp properties and buildings to the high standard our volunteers have come to expect in order to serve all girls. The Fall Product Sale also allows troops/groups in our council to earn money for the troop/group early in the Girl Scouting year.

GSVSC presents awards to the girls for online sales and direct sales of 12+ items, 25+ items, 50+ items, 75+ items and 100+ items; a SHARE patch for 5 Thank You Nut donation orders for our council-wide service project **Care to Share**; an online "Create & Earn" Super Hero Cat Patch; a Kindle Fire for the council's highest seller; and **NEW!** a personalized t-shirt.

For your daughter to participate in this sale, she must have a permission slip signed by her legal guardian and turned in to the troop leader. You will be responsible for receiving and selling the products and for monitoring her online sales. For the sale to be successful for your daughter's troop/group and the Girl Scout council, we will need your total cooperation in meeting all deadlines. The troop product sale manager will give you these dates at the troop training meeting.

Your daughter will have three ways to participate in the sale: door-to-door, troop booth sales and through her online shopping site. Friends and family can order photo keepsakes, new magazine subscriptions or renewals, AND nut, candy and gift items at the online shop. Instructions for helping your daughter set up her personal ordering site are included in the information on the Online Program Flyer included with her order card. Safety First

1. Girls should work in pairs, wearing the Girl Scout uniform or pin. Each girl should know whom to contact in an emergency.
2. Girls should never enter the home of a stranger.
3. Girls should use safe pedestrian practice, especially when crossing a street.
4. Girls should not carry large amounts of money.
5. Girls should participate in door-to-door sales only during daylight hours unless accompanied by an adult.
6. Girls should go only into neighborhoods familiar to them.
7. Parents should know the girls' whereabouts.
8. Online sales must be monitored by an adult.
