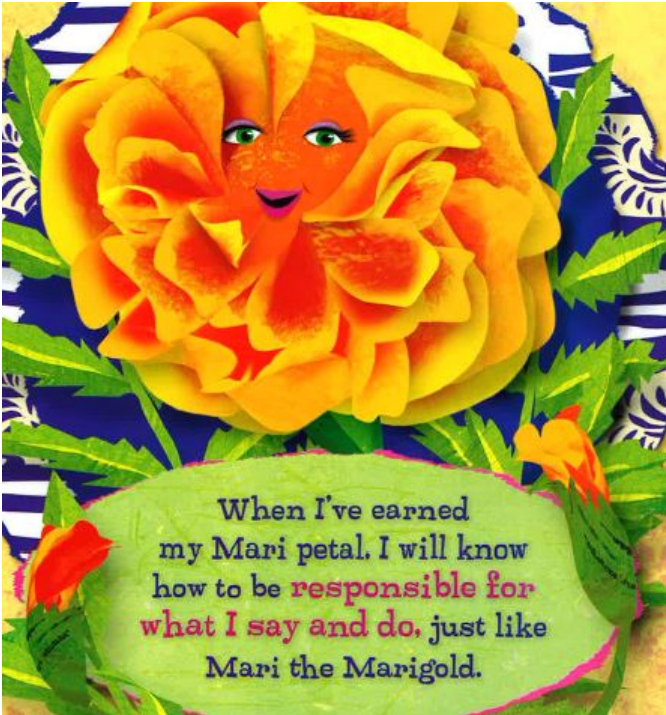


DAISY BADGES TO DO AT HOME

| Step 3 | Practice being responsible for what you say and do. | Think of a few ways that you can show, every day, how you are responsible for what you say and do. This might mean promising to put your toys away or make your bed—and then doing it! | The next time your family makes dinner, ask if you can do something to help. Set the table, help with a dish, clean up afterwards, etc. | Mari also showed how responsible she was by cleaning up the picnic table and leaving everything the way that she found it. Think of ways you can show your family how responsible you are—maybe by keeping track of your belongings, throwing away your trash after you've finished lunch, or picking up trash that others have left behind. |
