VIRGINIA SKYLINE COUNCIL PATCHES & T-SHIRTS



Many council t-shirts and patches have been made through the years. The very first council T-shirt was created for "New Worlds—New Directions," a 1979 council-wide event at Rockingham County Fair Grounds in Harrisonburg, VA. This event was attended by 2,357 girls and 593 adults. There were four themes for this event: It's a Small World (international), Tomorrow Land (world of 2000), SOS Earth (save our

spaceship), and Outer Spaces (outdoor experiences). Below are council patches throughout the years.
