Complete three activities.

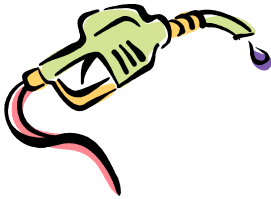
1. ITSCOOL Education: Participate in the ITSCOOL to Light Up the World Learning and Action Program by participating in the ITSCOOL education and doing the ITSCOOL booklet activities.
2. Story Discovery: Read a storybook about climate change and discuss the basic content. Below is a list of suggested books, which are all available for checkout from Girl Scouts of Virginia Skyline Council.

3. Picture Fun: Cut out pictures from newspapers and magazines to create a group collage or poster showing what causes climate change. Include pictures of cars, appliances, trash, and other forms of pollution.
4. Power Up: On the following page, match the pictures of different power sources with the words that describe them. Learn the difference between nonrenewable and renewable power sources. Discuss which kind is better for the environment.
5. Take Action: Make a plan to minimize pollution. Learn the connection between climate change and pollution. The plan can include recycling, reusing, reducing, composting, carpooling, etc. Make reminders to turn off the lights, recycle, and use less water and post them at home or at your troop meeting place.
6. Pledge to Make a Difference: Take the official Girl Scout Climate Change Daisy Pledge (coming soon). Learn about each action of the pledge, sign it, and submit it to Girl Scouts of the USA.
7. Climate Change Action Guide: Complete a suggested Daisy climate change activity from the Girl Scout Climate Change Action Guide (coming soon). Optional: Substitute several activities from the guide for other requirements.

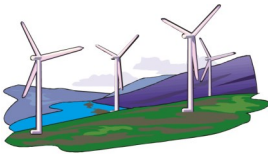

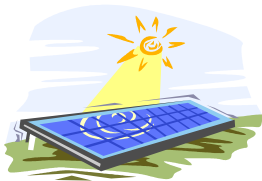
