

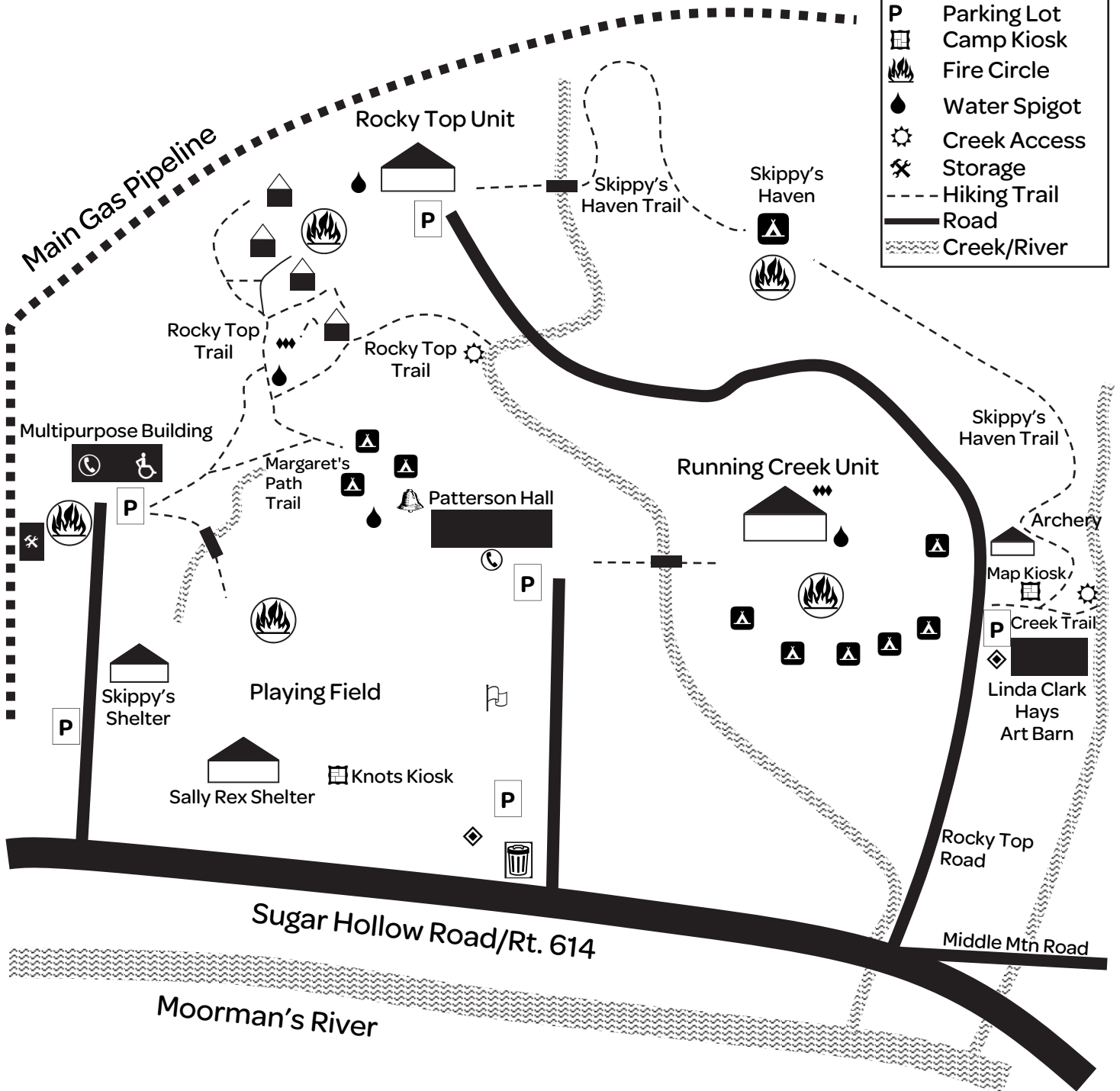
Camp Sugar Hollow

There are trails that connect each of the units and activity areas at Camp Sugar Hollow. The hike up to Skippy's Haven is a short, but challenging one. For those who want to hike a longer distance, a trip can be made to the reservoir, which is one mile up the road that goes by Camp Sugar Hollow.

Rocky Top Trail

Trail rating scale: easy (going down); moderate (going up)

Length (one-way): over 1/10th mile (various trails)

Trail blaze color: not blazed

Description: Many trails split-off from the Rocky Top Unit taking campers to unit features such as the latrine & water spigot. The trail heads down-hill from the unit and then forks a few times. The left-hand fork takes you to a creek access point, and the right-hand fork leads you to the Multipurpose Building and Margaret's Path Trail.

Margaret's Path Trail

Trail rating scale: easy

Length (one-way): less than 1/10th mile

Trail blaze color: not blazed

Description: A nice stroll through the woods with a bench to relax. The trail connects the Patterson Hall platform tents area to the Multipurpose Building via the Rocky Top Trail system.

Skippy's Haven Trail

Trail rating scale: moderate (going up); easy (going down)

Length (one-way): less than ¼ mile from the Rocky Top Unit or from the Creek Trail hillside

Trail blaze color: yellow

Description: This trail takes you to Skippy's Haven, a beautiful hilltop sanctuary with a campfire circle and primitive campsites. The trail can begin from either the Rocky Top Unit or from the Creek Trail/Linda Clark Hays Art Barn. It's a moderate to difficult climb up the hillside but once to the top a visit to Skippy's Haven is well-worth the effort! It's a very short climb overall but watch out for the tree roots.

Creek Trail

Trail rating scale: easy

Length (one-way): less than ¼ mile

Trail blaze color: red

Description: This trail starts to the left-side of the Linda Clark Hays Art Barn. It's a short forest walk to a creek access point that's nice for exploring and wading. The Skippy's Haven Trail forks off of this trail to the left up a hillside.

Playing Field ~ Multipurpose Building Trail

Trail rating scale: easy

Length (one-way): less than 1/10th mile

Trail blaze color: not blazed

Description: This trail takes you between the playing field and the multipurpose building. It includes a small foot bridge that takes you over the creek.
