

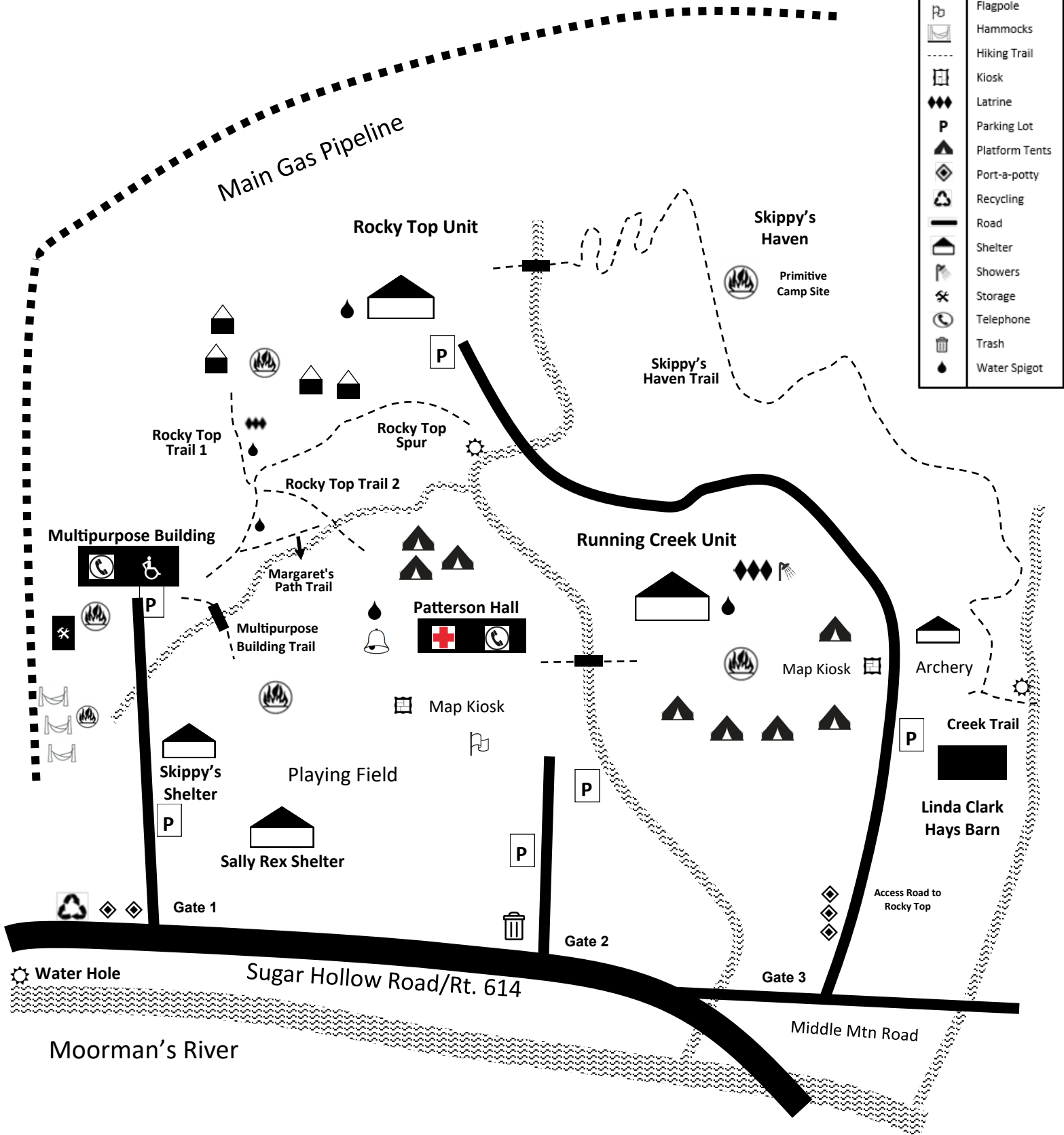

There are trails that connect each of the units and activity areas at Camp Sugar Hollow. For those who want to hike a longer distance, a trip can be made to the reservoir, which is approximately 1 mile West of Gate 2 on Sugar Hollow Road.

The Water Hole is pleasant place to cool down on hot summer days. It is a short walk located .07 tenth of a mile East of Gate 1 on the opposite side of the road from Camp Sugar Hollow. For safety reasons, please follow the rules that are posted on location at the Water Hole.

[Distance Reference: 1 mile = 1.0 1/2 mile = 0.50 tenths 1/4 mile = .25 tenth]

Skippy's Haven Trail

Trail rating scale: Challenging

Length: .32 tenth of a mile

Trail blaze color: Yellow

Description: This trail takes you to Skippy's Haven, a hilltop sanctuary for primitive camping with a campfire circle. The trail can begin from either, Rocky Top Unit or from Creek Trail near the Linda Clark Hays Barn. It's a smoother climb to Skippy's Haven starting from the Rocky Top Unit side to the top. It becomes a much more challenging trail the closer you get to Creek Trail from Skippy's Haven.

Rocky Top Trail 1 & 2 and Spur

Trail rating scale: Moderate

Length total: .15 tenth of a mile

Trail blaze color: Red

Trail 1 .06 tenths of a mile. A uphill trail from the Multipurpose Building to Rocky Top Unit.

Trail 2 .03 tenths of a mile. A uphill trail with stairs that begins behind Patterson Hall and leads to the Rocky Top Unit.

Spur .06 mile. The trail begins from Rocky Top Trail 1 and leads to the creek. There is a fire pit and bench style seating.

Margaret's Path Trail

Trail rating scale: Easy

Length: .04 tenth of a mile

Trail blaze color: Blue

Description: A nice stroll through the woods. The trail connects Rocky Top Trail 1 & 2. You can begin from behind Patterson Hall, from the Rocky Top Trail 2 or just beyond the Multipurpose Building via the Rocky Top Trail 1.

Multipurpose Building Trail

Trail rating scale: Easy

Length: .02 tenths of a mile

Trail blaze color: Green

Description: The trail can be located at the Playing Field near the firepit and at the Multipurpose Building. It includes a small foot bridge that takes you over a small wet/dry creek.

Creek Trail

Trail rating scale: Easy

Length: .01 tenths of a mile

Trail blaze color: Orange

Description: This trail starts beyond Linda Clark Hays Art Barn. It's a short walk to a creek access point that's nice for exploring and wading. The Skippy's Haven Trail forks off of this trail on the left going up the hillside.
